Working at the Grassroots to Fight the Culture of Death

Imagine if somehow abortion on demand had been made illegal in 2002 in all 50 states. Would abortion have stopped? Most likely, many abortionists would simply have gone underground. Many women would have gone north to Canada. An offshore abortion industry would have popped up overnight. Without widespread support, millions of pre-born babies would continue to have died by abortion!



Several weeks ago, I received a call from **Cal Zastro** who lives in upstate Michigan. Cal had just returned from **Colorado** where there was a personhood initiative on the November 4 ballot in that state. This ballot initiative simply stated that **human life begins at conception**. Even though it lost overwhelmingly, over **500,000** citizens of Colorado voted the right way. It all started with a 20-year-old young lady who did not accept the conventional wisdom that *such things are simply not possible*. Out of this defeat, good things are already happening. For example, there are four new pregnancy centers that have already been established!

Can God bring good out of defeat? The answer is a resounding YES!

Maybe such a ballot initiative is exactly what is needed in various states throughout America. States like Mississippi and Louisiana, which were embarrassed when pro-abortion Colorado beat them to the punch, are now considering such an initiative. Think of how many new pro-lifers could be recruited into the movement with the names and addresses we would obtain from the petition drive needed to get this initiative on the ballot.

Please think and pray about such an effort in your state!

The point is that we must work from the bottom up, not from the top down. More than ever, we must continue to do and increase the things that **DEFEND LIFE** has been doing for the past 21 years including:

40 Days for Life Produced Great Results Locally

Here are some of the highlights:

• The 40 Days at the Hillcrest in Catonsville, Maryland, produced great

40 DAYS FOR LIFE... results including three saves. Thanks to **Tim McCarthy**, the organizer, who personally spent over 80 hours at Hillcrest and parishes like St. Louis, Clarksville, and St. John's, Westminster who each took an entire day.

Here are some of the details of one of the saves. A woman scheduled for an abortion saw the sign PRAY TO END ABORTION before she entered the back door of the Suburbia Building where Hillcrest Abortuary is located. All access to Hillcrest is from the back door parking lot side which makes it impossible to sidewalk counsel since pro-lifers must be on the locked front door sidewalk Route 40 side of the building. The woman was escorted by three men. After going in the back door, this woman simply sat down in the corridor. She was visible to the pro-lifers who were out front since this corridor is clearly visible through the all-glass locked front doors. The three men were obviously trying to coerce her into having an abortion and getting her to board the elevator to the abortuary which is on the sixth floor. At one point, she walked the length of the corridor to the locked front doors to see if the pro-lifers were still praying for her. Minutes later, she and the three men coercing her were seen leaving and driving west on Route 40. Such is the power or prayer!

- Jody Hammond of St. John's in Frederick headed up the effort in Frederick and recruited 60 persons from that parish. This abortuary was completely covered Monday through Saturday 12 hours a day. As a result, three other nearby parishes who participated are now starting parish pro-life groups. They include St. Timothy's, Walkersville; St. Francis of Assisi, Brunswick; and Holy Family, Middletown.
- In Severna Park, a group of Evangelicals from Living Hope Church in Glen Burnie and Severn United Church in Severn, spearheaded an effort at the Gynecare Abortuary. So successful was this effort that one of the primary organizers, Michael Martelli, is in the process of doing the following:
 - Having a weekly 30 minute public access TV program featuring pro-life activists (this program has already begun).
 - Sponsoring a weekly pro-life radio program featuring interviews with pro-life activists.
 - Retiring 67-year-old Filipino abortionist **Romeo Ferrer** who sucks apart pre-born babies six days a week. Be watching for www.retireferrer.com which will be coming out soon. If you have any information at all about abortionist Romeo Ferrer, please e-mail Michael michael@mywebguv.com.

Bishop Rhoades also told Father Pavone that he and any of his **Priests for Life**will always be welcome in parishes throughout the Diocese of Harrisburg.
